WHEREAS, according to the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), “alcohol and drug use by persons under age 21 is a major public health problem;” and

WHEREAS, according to the National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism (NIAAA), “underage alcohol use is more likely to kill young people than all illegal drugs combined;” and

WHEREAS, The National Council on Alcoholism and Drug Dependence, Inc. (NCADD) reports that “Alcohol use by young people is extremely dangerous—both to themselves and to society, and is directly associated with traffic fatalities, violence, suicide, educational failure, alcohol overdose, unsafe sex and other problem behaviors;” and

WHEREAS, according to the 2019 Georgia Student Health Survey, 91% of Camden Youth don’t engage in the unearthy activity of drinking; and

WHEREAS, the 2019 Georgia Student Health Survey also reports that the average age of first alcohol use in Camden County is between 14 and 16 years old; and

WHEREAS, Youth, with the care and support from family, friends, health professionals, teachers, clergy and others, can avoid the negative effects of alcohol and drugs; and

WHEREAS, Camden Connection invites all residents of Camden County to participate in Red Ribbon Week annually by promoting a drug and alcohol free lifestyle to all youth in Camden County;

PURPOSE:

- a. To request that the Board of Commissioners consider approval of an intergovernmental agreement between Camden County, Ga. and Nassau County Florida for Solid Waste Disposal Capacity at the MSW and C&D Landfills, for a period of ten years until October 31, 2030.

HISTORY:

1. Agreement between Camden Co. and Nassau County was approved by the Camden Co. Commission on 9/15/2009.
2. Agreement between Camden Co. and Nassau Co. is for disposal capacity at the MSW and C&D landfill sites.
3. Nassau Co. has agreed to pay the rate established by the rate study with annual increase.
4. Camden County will provide disposal space for Nassau Co. solid waste disposal. Nassau Co. will meet their states requirement for 10 years of solid waste disposal capacity.

FACTS & ISSUES:

1. Camden County has the disposal capacity for Nassau County's solid waste disposal.
2. This will be the second agreement with Nassau County for disposal capacity.

SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL CAPACITY AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into this 28TH day of September, 2020, by and between NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "NASSAU" and CAMDEN COUNTY, GEORGIA, a political subdivision of the State of Georgia, hereinafter referred to as "CAMDEN".

WITNESSEDETH:

WHEREAS, NASSAU is obligated under Florida law to provide for the solid waste disposal needs of its residents, within both the unincorporated and incorporated area of Nassau County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, NASSAU will implement a procedure to provide for the collection of solid waste at a convenient center location at the existing solid waste landfill to collect solid waste from county residents who do not have access to curbside pickup; and

WHEREAS, NASSAU is seeking assurances that there will be a lawfully permitted and environmentally safer solid waste disposal facility available to NASSAU and those haulers serving the residents of Nassau County to properly dispose of solid waste generated within Nassau County; and

WHEREAS, CAMDEN owns and operates a solid waste disposal facility approved and certified by the State of Georgia and managed and operated by the CAMDEN COUNTY SOLID WASTE AUTHORITY, an authority established pursuant to Georgia Law, and CAMDEN desires to enter into this AGREEMENT to provide air space to NASSAU in the Camden County Landfill Solid Waste Disposal Facility pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth herein; and

WHEREAS, the Camden County Landfill Solid Waste Disposal Facility has capacity to provide for the solid waste disposal needs of the residents of Nassau County and NASSAU desires to enter into this AGREEMENT to assure NASSAU air space within the Camden County Landfill Solid Waste Disposal Facility upon the terms and conditions set forth herein:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties hereto agree, as follows:

1. All of the recitals contained herein are true and correct.

2. CAMDEN hereby agrees to accept at its solid waste disposal facility all of the solid non-hazardous waste generated within Nassau County and transported to the Camden County Landfill Solid Waste Disposal Facility by NASSAU.
3. NASSAU shall pay to CAMDEN the rate of \$24.36 per ton of solid non-hazardous waste delivered by vehicles owned and operated by NASSAU. CAMDEN shall have the right to increase the above referenced rate in the amount of any direct charges imposed upon CAMDEN by state or federal environmental protection agencies having jurisdiction over its solid waste disposal facility. This AGREEMENT may be extended for a period of five (5) years upon the condition that NASSAU provide to CAMDEN a written notice of the intent to renew no later than 180 days prior to the tenth (10th) anniversary date. In the event CAMDEN does not intend to renew this AGREEMENT for the five (5) year renewal period Camden shall notify NASSAU by written notice of the intent not to renew AGREEMENT. If renewed, a written addendum is to be lawfully adopted and made part of this AGREEMENT.

NASSAU agrees that in consideration for entering this AGREEMENT with CAMDEN for the acceptance of solid non-hazardous waste from NASSAU and the solid waste haulers operating with Nassau County; that NASSAU shall utilize the Camden County Landfill Solid Waste Disposal Facility as NASSAU's primary solid waste disposal facility.

Nothing in this AGREEMENT shall be construed to require NASSAU or any solid waste hauler conducting business within Nassau County to deliver its solid waste to the Camden County Landfill Solid Waste Disposal Facility, nor shall NASSAU be obligated to mandate disposal of any solid waste generated within Nassau County at the Camden County Landfill Solid Waste Disposal Facility.

As such, the parties hereto recognize the potential detrimental and impacts that material breaches of this AGREEMENT could have if CAMDEN refuses to accept waste from NASSAU pursuant to the provisions of this AGREEMENT.

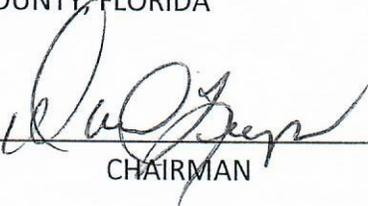

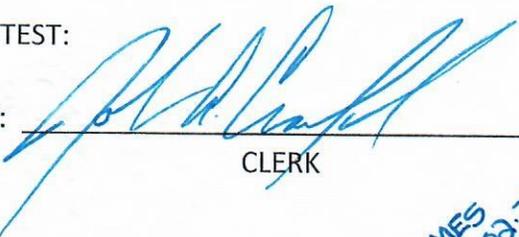

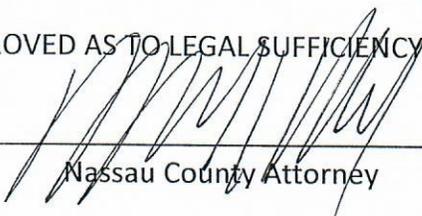

SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL CAPACITY AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into this 28TH day of September, 2020, by and between NASSAU COUNTY, FLORIDA, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "NASSAU" and CAMDEN COUNTY, GEORGIA, a political subdivision of the State of Georgia, hereinafter referred to as "CAMDEN".
