



## Public Notice Still Changing Hurricane Dorian Forecast Requires Further Monitoring

**WOODBINE, Ga. – August 31, 2019** – As the still changing forecast for Hurricane Dorian continues to evolve, all Camden County residents should continue to monitor the path of Hurricane Dorian and take preparedness actions. We are closely monitoring Hurricane Dorian in consultation with the National Weather Service Office in Jacksonville, Georgia Emergency Management Agency (GEMA) and Governor Brian Kemp's Office for additional protective measures that may be necessary. Camden County Board of Commissioners, Emergency Management Agency (EMA), and Camden County Sheriff's Office, and in partnership with the cities of Kingsland, St. Marys, and Woodbine, along with Camden County Schools, and Naval Submarine Base Kings Bay are continuing to work together to coordinate incident response and public communications.
