Public Notice
Functional, Access, and Medical Needs Relocation

WOODBINE, Ga. – September 1, 2019 – Out of an abundance of caution the Camden County Director of Emergency Management made the decision to relocate the Camden County Health Department’s Functional, Access, and Medical Needs Hurricane Registry. Camden County continues to work with our partners at the National Weather Service in Jacksonville to monitor Hurricane Dorian. The movement of this storm has slowed, but its intensity has increased. As a result, the timing and extent of impacts on our region are still unknown.

Local residents are also encouraged to visit the National Hurricane Center, www.nhc.noaa.gov, and the National Weather Service Office in Jacksonville, www.weather.gov/jax, as trusted sites for weather related information. Camden County residents are urged to sign-up for the CodeRED Emergency Notification System by visiting www.camdencountyga.gov/CodeRED or texting “CamdenCodeRED” to 99411. CodeRED is critical during situations like this as a direct method of communication from Camden County EMA to your landline, cell phone, or email. TDD/TTY service is also available. Participants will be notified in the event of emergency situations or critical community alerts.
