**WOODBINE, Ga. – September 2, 2019** – Officials from the Camden County Board of Commissioners and the Cities of Kingsland, St. Marys, and Woodbine jointly agreed to close all local government offices Tuesday, September 3, 2019, through Thursday, September 5, 2019. The safety of our staff and customers are our first priority. At this time the opening of government offices on Friday, September 6, 2019, is still being reviewed and dependent upon local conditions post-storm.
