Camden County Recommended for Nonpoint Source Implementation Grant

Woodbine, GA – June 15, 2009: On Friday, June 12, 2009, the Camden County Board of Commissioners received notice from Georgia Department of Natural Resources that after review by the Georgia Environmental Protection Division, a recommendation has been made to the U.S. Environmental Protection Division to fund the Section 319(h) Nonpoint Source Implementation Grant to Strengthen Erosion & Sedimentation Control Enforcement in Camden County. This project has been recommended for funding with a federal budget of \$141,698.00 over a three year period. *“I am proud to share the great news that Camden County has been recommended for this funding opportunity. The grant process was extremely competitive and the success is truly a testament to the efforts of our employees working together,”* said Steve L. Howard, County Administrator.
