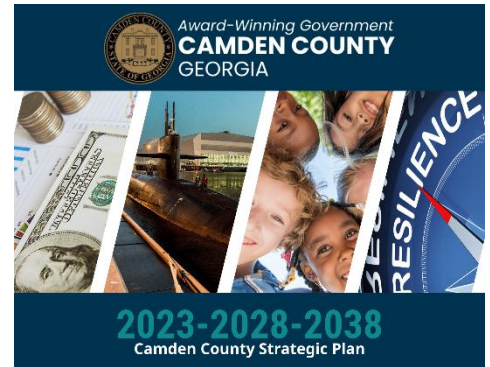

2023-2028-2038 Strategic Plan Available Online

WOODBINE, Ga. — February 23, 2023 — The 2023-2028-2038 Strategic Plan is now available online. The Camden County Board of Commissioners unanimously adopted the 2023 Strategic Plan and 2023 Action Agenda at their February 7, 2023, regular meeting. The Strategic Plan is a five-year, outcome-based set of goals with specific issues and projects that need to be addressed by the County, all with measurable objectives.

“Through the leadership of the Board of Commissioners and their commitment to planning, Camden County continues to work towards being prepared for tomorrow,” said County Administrator Shawn M. Boatright. “The Strategic Plan and Action Agenda allows citizens to see both the short term goals and long term direction for our community.”

In late November and early December, the Board of Commissioners and county staff met to review the many accomplishments of 2022 and primarily focused on the action agenda and future direction of the County for the upcoming years ahead. The Strategic Plan and Action Agenda provide the citizens of Camden a detailed look at the short, medium, and long term priorities of the county.
