

Memorandum of Understanding **Vector Launch, Inc. and Camden County Board of Commissioners**

January 30, 2019

WHEREAS, The Camden County Board of Commissioners are developing Spaceport Camden (collectively referred to within as “Spaceport Camden”) as a world class spaceport through public-private partnership in Camden County Georgia,

AND WHEREAS, Vector Launch, Inc. (Vector) is building a commercial business providing launch services for small satellites,

AND WHEREAS, Spaceport Camden has expressed an interest in Vector as a commercial user and early pathfinder of its spaceport,

AND WHEREAS, Vector has an interest in establishing Spaceport Camden as a key launch site supplier for steady-state operations,

AND WHEREAS, Spaceport Camden has already hosted a Vector launch and has expressed an ongoing interest in hosting future launches of Vector’s developmental launch vehicles under an FAA Part 101 Waiver,

AND WHEREAS, Vector has already successfully flown an early version of its launch vehicle at Spaceport Camden under an FAA Part 101 Waiver and has expressed an interest in performing an early flight of its current developmental launch vehicle at Spaceport Camden,

AND WHEREAS, Spaceport Camden and Vector are in good faith discussions with mutual intention of executing a contract whereby Vector contracts for access to an appropriate launch site to launch its launch vehicle as described in this document from Spaceport Camden.

THE PARTIES HAVE HEREBY AGREED to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to facilitate an early understanding of the contracted launch site access and launch support services in advance of a formal contract:

1. **Access:** Spaceport Camden shall provide to Vector a launch site within the boundaries of Spaceport Camden to be used for the launch of Vector’s launch vehicle to suborbital altitudes. Such access will allow Vector to engage in standard operations, the details of which are to be worked out in the anticipated contract.
2. **Launch Support:** Spaceport Camden will provide to Vector support services specified by Vector that are required to facilitate its launch, though these are expected to be minimal with the expectation that Vector will remain mostly mobile and autonomous in operation. These details of the launch support services will be agreed in the anticipated contract.

3. **Launch Schedule:** The current timeframe for the launch is within 2QCY19. Timing adjustments are possible as each party optimizes its schedule and will be reflected in the contract.
4. **Confidentiality and Press:** It is the desire of Vector to engage in mutually beneficial press activities that are coordinated and executed to the benefit of both parties. Specific rules on confidentiality and press interactions will be agreed in a separate confidentiality agreement or the contract, whichever comes first. Until such agreement is executed all information on the launch proposed herein will be held in the strictest of confidence and press engagements will be coordinated with Vector on a case-by-case basis.
5. **Contract:** It is the goal of this Memorandum of Understanding to establish general terms that will form the basis of a contract to be negotiated in good faith and promptly executed for launch site access and Vector-specified launch support services.
6. **Non-Binding:** Camden Spaceport and Vector agree that the terms set forth herein are intended as an outline for a formal agreement for launch site access and launch support services and only reflect their current understanding of the discussions they have had to date.
7. **Authority:** Each person executing this MOU represents that he or she has full and legal authority to execute this MOU for and on behalf of the respective party he or she represents.

This non-binding MOU will remain in effect until a formal contract is executed.
