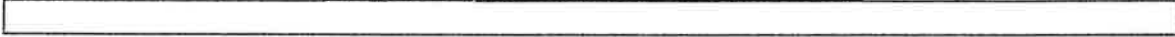

- Worked with Linda Strine to schedule March 9 briefing to Col Rose and team
 - Drafted proposed topics to be covered by Camden
 - Asked Linda to review topics
 - Arranged for dry run with Linda, Steve, Brian Gulliver to ensure major issues covered
- Discussion with Steve re: status of review of conservation agency letter and FAA positive reply + next steps with AST leading to site license approval
- Participated in CSF sponsored spaceport forum, hosted by Pam Underwood, FAA Spaceport Office Director, in which State Dept briefed on ITAR related issues.
- Continued to facilitate meetings with the Hines Foundation and Georgia partnerships to include beta project in Camden County School district– with long term aim of establishing a facility for using space technology to motivate underserved students.
- Ongoing strategy sessions with Steve Howard and team re: proceeding to site license, as well as pursuing Federal policy/regulatory support for spaceports and BD opportunities.
- Update from DoD – Kathleen Loyd – re: final steps involving Navy response and DoD formal “conveyance to the FAA AST. Expectation is final response on site license and EIS by end of March.
- Reviewed and commented on deck for Col Rose on March 9, including addition of Agenda chart to frame discussion.
- Participated in CSF Spaceports March 8 meeting re: spaceport priorities such as encouraging FAA to appropriately fund and resource Office of Spaceports re: infrastructure issues, grants, etc.
- Worked with Col Rose’s staff to reschedule Spaceport Camden briefing to March 23, as well as coordinated with staff to ensure that presentation ran as smoothly as possible.
- Reached out to DoD multiple times to ensure final clearance of DOD approval submission to FAA AST was on track.
