- Participated in CSF comment/review of new launch regs and impact on Camden. Plus, sent summary of comments to Steve and team.
- Follow-up to introduction to John Hines Family Foundation as part of efforts to encourage satellite campus/STEM activities in Camden.
- Helped support informational briefing to Senate Commerce Minority staff re: potential challenge posed by Space Force consideration of consolidation of East and West Test Ranges into National Range Corporation type model.
 - Informal outreach to Virginia Spaceport Director to gauge assessment of National Range threat. He is assuming a wait and see stance.
- Initiated call with senior Parsons leadership re: potential interest in strategic relationship with Spaceport Camden, including infrastructure partner. (This is ongoing effort.)
