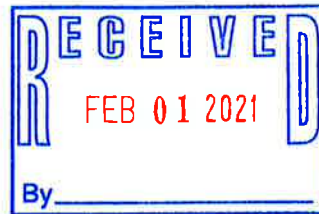

- Off-line informational calls with FAA AST leadership to affirm that site license is moving toward March/April timeline. Debriefed Steve. Among other issues, need to keep focus on status of EIS Directive during transition to new Administration.
- Hosted call with Linda Strine, Principal Systems Engineer, Centauri Corporation, support for SMSC re: assisting manifesting security payloads. Initiated exploratory dialogue re: briefing Col Rose and team as to the long potential of mid-Atlantic launch venue.
- Initiated series of discussions with John Hines, Chair, Hines Family Foundation concerning local pilot school program to validate use of student friendly tools such as FarmBot to demonstrate power of space technology for applications such as precise agricultural.
- Helped coordinated call with Dr. Justin Ballenger, Director of the STEM Education Innovation (S.E.I.) Lab on Mercer's Atlanta Campus, regarding collaboration with Hines Foundation and Camden on pilot project in Camden school district that would demonstrate potential for rapid scaling up.
 - Next steps include short "road map" from Hines/Ballenger that Camden can review and use as basis for team call with Superintendent of Schools.
- Reached out to Mark Lester of AADC, to discuss agenda for CSF Spaceport Committee and reinforce need for near collaboration with Camden to work together on issues such as the prospect of National Spaceport Corporation, as well as need term issues specific to both spaceports.
- Reconnected with Linda Strine re: preliminary briefing schedule per site license.
- Informal outreach to DoD official to ensure interagency issues per Camden effectively managed.
