Stuart Sullivan named Camden County's Employee of the Quarter

Woodbine, Ga. (April 20, 2011) – On Tuesday, April 19, 2011 at the regular scheduled Board of County Commissioner's meeting, Stuart C. Sullivan was recognized as the Employee of the Quarter for the 3rd quarter of Fiscal Year 2011 for Camden County Government. Stuart has been a dedicated employee of Camden County Fire Rescue since January 2005. His commitment has played an important role in the growth and success of this organization. His overall training and dedication as a Firefighter has greatly benefit Camden County as well as the State of Georgia. Stuart has a can do attitude and is constantly keeping everyone around him upbeat, as well as taking on tasks that are not normally his to make our organization run smooth.



In 2010, Stuart co-founded the Andrew Cohn AED Project to raise money to purchase Automatic External Defibrillators (AED) to serve as a life saving measure should an individual suffer cardiac arrest. After receiving donated funds through an AED manufacture, Cardiac Science, as well as from the Firehouse Subs Public Safety Foundation, he was able to purchase five (5) AED devices to start the "Borrow an AED" program through Camden County Fire Rescue and the Andrew Cohn AED Project. This program allows organizations and individuals to borrow an AED for various events and sports activities to potentially save a life in the event of an emergency. Stuart also took time to receive training as a Basic Life Support Instructor so he could teach people how use an AED device. He actively lobbies before the Georgia General Assembly to change laws that would require all Georgia Public
