Camden County and PATH Foundation receive ACCG's 2011 Public-Private Partnership of the Year Award

Woodbine, Ga. (May 3, 2011) – On Monday, May 2, 2011, Camden County and the PATH Foundation were proud recipients of the 2011 Public-Private Partnership of the Year award presented by the Association County Commissioners of Georgia (ACCG) for the Coastal Georgia Rail-Trail in White Oak. Chair David L. Rainer and County Administrator Steve L. Howard were in attendance as Camden County and Fred Freyer of Coastal Georgia Rails to Trail, Inc. (on behalf of Ed McBrayer, Executive Director of the PATH Foundation), were formally recognized at the Savannah Civic Center for participation in this important project.



The first 3.5 mile section of the Georgia Coast Rail-Trail officially opened last year on June 5, 2010, in White Oak, Georgia. The recycled surface accommodates walkers, runner, and cyclists. Equestrians can ride on the grassy area alongside the trail. Amenities include a picnic shelter and benches. Restroom facilities will be added as funds become available. Steve Howard stated, *"This project was a huge success, leveraging private funds to accomplish a shared vision of enhancing Camden's quality of life for future generations."*
