CCFR Takes Delivery Of Two New 3,000 Gallon Tankers



Woodbine, GA. (November 5, 2013) - In preparation for its upcoming ISO (Insurance Services Office) inspection, Camden County Fire Rescue (CCFR) has purchased two new 3,000 gallon water tankers. CCFR has increased its area of fire protection since the last ISO inspection and one of these tankers will be assigned to that new area of protection. The other tanker will be assigned to a fire station with high call volume to replace a high mileage tanker. That older tanker will then be reassigned to an area with fewer calls thereby extending its life expectancy. In addition to improving the ISO rating the new tankers will help CCFR better allocate resources and better protect the citizens of Camden County.

ISO is an independent agency that rates fire departments on their ability to delivery fire suppression services based on a scale of 10 to 1. A rating of one is the best possible classification a fire department can obtain. CCFR is currently a Class 4 fire department.
