County Offices to Remain Closed Due to Winter Weather

WOODBINE, GEORGIA – January 3, 2018 – After carefully monitoring the conditions on the ground and the latest forecast for the coastal area, County Officials have decided to keep all Camden County offices closed Thursday, January 4, 2018. The safety of our staff and customers remain our first priority.

The wet roads combined with below-freezing temperatures overnight have the potential to cause black ice throughout the county. This, coupled with the increasing number of downed power lines, lead to an unsafe situation for all drivers. All Camden County residents are urged to stay off of the roads.
